AGREEMENT ON SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL CO-OPERATION BETWEEN UNIVERSITY OF RIJEKA, CROATIA AND HANKUK UNIVERSITY OF FOREIGN STUDIES, KOREA

According to the mutual wish to promote the international co-operation, University of Rijeka, represented by Prof. Daniel Rukavina, M.D., D.Sc., Rector and Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, represented by Prof. Park Chul, Ph.D., President, execute the present agreement on scientific, educational and cultural co-operation.

ARTICLE 1

Within fields of common interest, both Universities will promote the following activities:

- 1. Exchanges of scientists for lectures, conferences and scientific meetings;
- 2. Student exchanges;
- 3. Scientific and educational exchanges.

ARTICLE 2

Details of common activities, proposed by scientists of both parts, and formalities regarding visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will be agreed upon and authorised by the representatives of the two Universities, subject to the availability of funds.

ARTICLE 3

This agreement is opened to all fields of common interest.

ARTICLE 4

Travel expenses for scientists will be born by the University of origin.

ARTICLE 5

The present agreement will come into force after approval of the Academic bodies and the signature by the representatives of the two Universities.

This agreement will be in force for one year and will be tacitly renewed, unless rescinded by one of the parties at least three months before its date of expiry.
